JANUARY 28 2019 CPR / AED	Learn the basics of respiratory and cardiac arrest, understand the signs and symptoms and receive hands on training in CPR and AED.
FEBRUARY 25 2019 SEIZURES	Causes and care for seizure events both known and unknown.
MARCH 25 2019 BREAKS/SPRAINS/STRAINS	A common occurrence during a disaster – You can practice how to stabilize, splint and care for various incidents.
APRIL 29 2019 ALL ABOUT KIDS	Baby & Child CPR and First Aid, review differences in physiology and care. Bring your questions – as well as experience!

AUGUST 26 2019 DEADLY BLEEDS	What's considered deadly, serious or minor – how do we treat and when is it severe enough to be considered life threatening?
SEPTEMBER 30 2019 BURNS	Chemical, electrical & thermal – all need to be cared for in unique ways. Learn some strategies to reduce pain and chance of infection.
OCTOBER 28 2019 WOUND CARE	A common day-to-day injury, ranging from simple scrapes and road rash, to impalement and large gashes from falling debris.
